Setting Your Career S.M.A.R.T Goal



- Establishes the foundation for everything else you will do to prepare for your next opportunity.
- Is the foundation of this webinar series
 - Specific
 - Measurable
 - Achievable
 - Realistic
 - Time Sensitive











Setting Your Career S.M.A.R.T Goal



- Specific (role, type of club, location, compensation, on court hours)
- Measurable (metrics for achievement compensation versus teaching)
- Achievable (realistic per previous experience and time-frame)
- Relevant (aligned with your horizon objectives i.e. next job/lifestyle)

• Time-bound (a "squishy" deadline that helps determine actions)









A Career S.M.A.R.T Goal Example



- Director of Racquets at a member owned club in the southeastern region (i.e. North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida) with at least two racquet sports. The ideal club will have 8-12 tennis courts, 6-8 pickleball courts and 3-4 assistant pros with instructional revenue of \$400K - \$500K, with visible opportunity for growth, by December 31, 2026.
- The ideal location will be Jacksonville, FL. (however, I am willing to relocate anywhere in this geographic region) and the club will be family-oriented with about 1000 +/- members that values a healthy work/life balance.
- Ideal total compensation package will be \$180K \$200K plus benefits, with a base salary of \$90K - \$110K and approximately 15-20 hours of weekly on court teaching.
